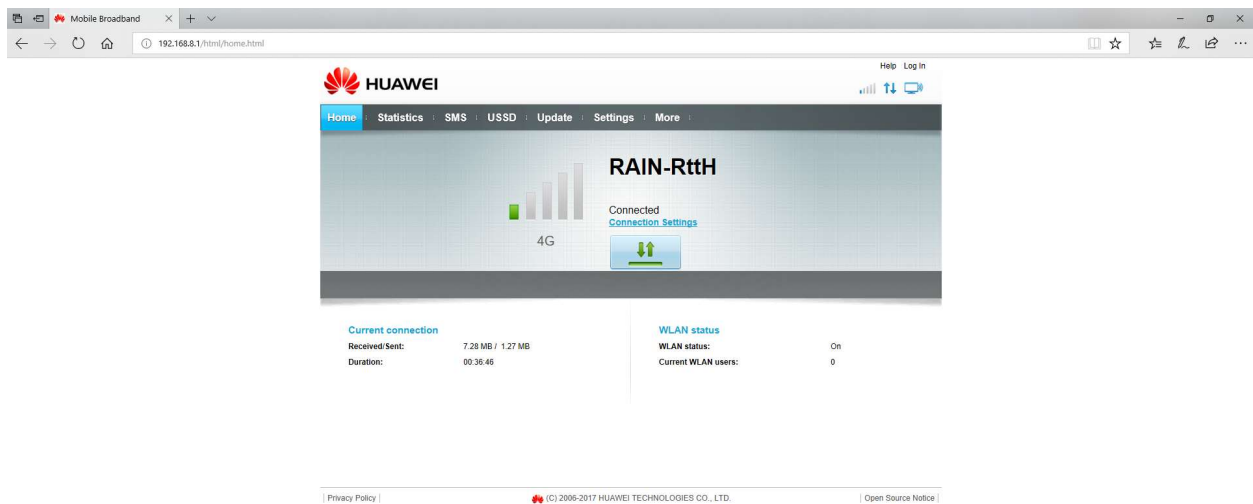
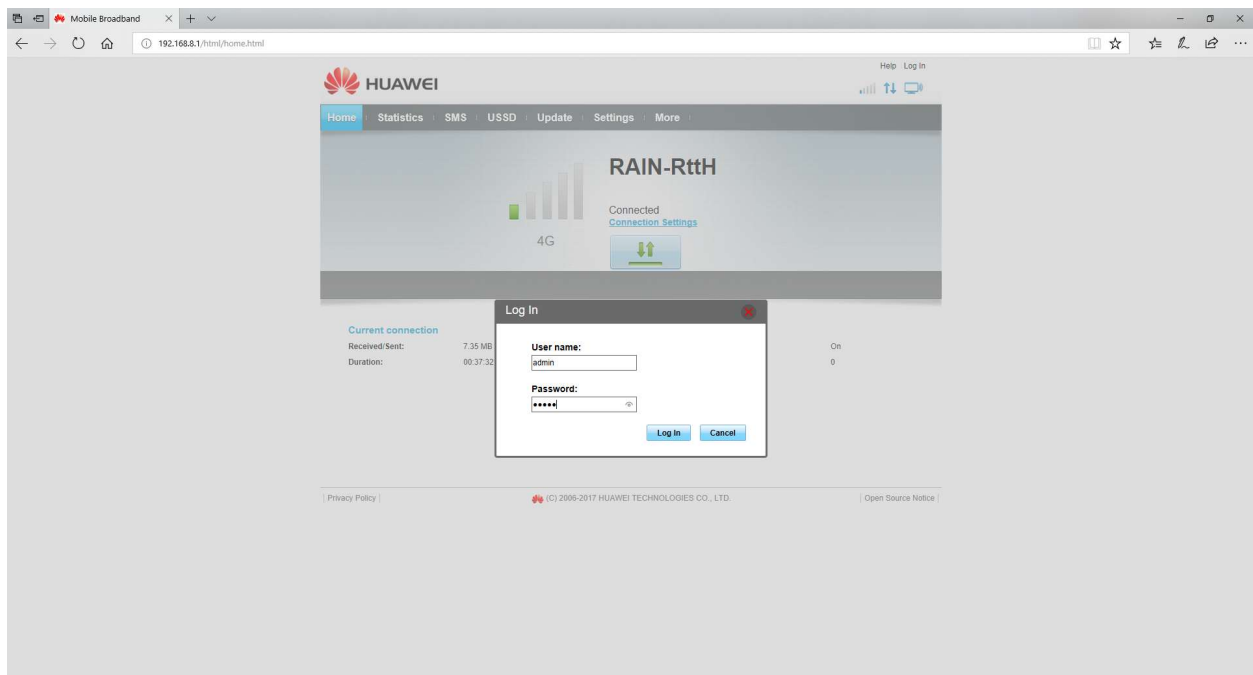


Adjusting B315/B618 APN for Cell-C

To log into the router you will need to type 192.168.8.1 into a web browser. The default username and password will be **admin/admin** but you will only be prompted for that once you select the **Settings** option.



Once on this page select **Settings** and enter the above mentioned login details.



The B618 will request a password change which you can just go along with.

Once logged in you will select **Dial-Up** on the left of the screen.
